Mashia experienced Home Forward's programs as a child living in two Home Forward public housing communities, Columbia Villa (now New Columbia) and Hillsdale Terrace (now Stephens Creek Crossing). "This gives me a unique perspective as we consider policies that affect thousands of people in our community," she said. "I know firsthand how these programs can help people move ahead in their lives, because that's just what I did."

She said her board service was "an opportunity to give back to the organization and the community that helped me early in life."
